

RE: CGS 8-24 Referral for Capital Improvement Plan

At its meeting on March 9, 2026, the Planning and Zoning Commission made the following decision:

The Coventry Planning and Zoning Commission recommends that the Town Council pursue the Capital Improvement Program Budget for fiscal years 2026/2027 through 2030/2031.

The Commission suggests that the Town Council prioritize the following:

- 1) Projects to update and improve existing water and sewer infrastructure including, in order of priority: 1) the sewage treatment plant upgrades and 2) the Village water tower project,
- 2) Projects to maintain and enhance roads, bridges and culverts,
- 3) Projects that add to or improve upon existing open space,
- 4) Projects to improve the water quality of Coventry Lake,
- 5) Projects to improve the quality and usability of parks, such as Patriots Park and Miller-Richardson Park,
- 6) Projects to improve the quality of public data such as the GIS tax maps.
