


**Notification of Aquatic Treatment  
Coventry Lake – Coventry**

In accordance with the Connecticut DEEP, Pesticide Division notification requirements, a portion of Coventry Lake in Coventry will be chemically treated with the USEPA/CT DEEP registered herbicide Aquathol-K® (endothall) to control non-native *Hydrilla* on August 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. The location of the treatment area is shown on the map below.



On August 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, the area within and for a distance of 500-feet beyond the treatment area will be closed to all uses, including swimming, boating, fishing and irrigation. Additionally, use of the lake water in the same area for livestock watering and direct drinking/domestic use will be restricted for 14 full days after the treatment (until August 27<sup>th</sup>). The CT DEEP boat ramp will remain open. Prior to the treatment, the shoreline will be posted with signs in accordance with DEEP requirements.

The work is being performed for the CT DEEP and Town of Coventry pursuant to a permit issued by the CT DEEP. Information on the application may be obtained from the person named below.
