

**LEGAL NOTICE
TOWN OF COVENTRY
ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE**

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-5 of the Charter of the Town of Coventry, the Town Council, at a meeting held on February 21, 2017 adopted an amendment to Section 2.191 of the Town Code currently entitled: "Veterans Memorial Commission".

The amended Ordinance expands the duties of the Commission to help honor those who served in all recognized wars and conflicts and to clarify the Commission's authority.

In accordance with the Town Charter and with Section 7-157(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes, the foregoing summary has been provided in lieu of publishing the amended ordinance in full. This document is prepared for the benefit of the public, solely for purposes of information, summarization and explanation. This document does not represent the intent of the Town Council of the Town of Coventry for any purpose. The foregoing amended ordinance will take effect 21 days after publication of this notice.

Amendment to the Veterans Memorial Commission

DIVISION 3. - VETERANS MEMORIAL COMMISSION

Sec. 2-191. - Creation; purpose.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 3-4 of the Town Charter the town hereby creates a Veterans Memorial Commission. The purpose of the Veterans Memorial Commission is to:

- (1) Review and assess all existing memorials for veterans and to recommend action for their repair and maintenance to the town council;
- (2) Make recommendations to the town council with regard to memorials that would honor all of the town's veterans who served in all officially recognized wars and conflicts, as they may deem appropriate; and
- (3) Take such action as authorized by the town council with respect to its recommendations.

Sec. 2-192. - Composition; political affiliation.

The Veterans Memorial Commission shall consist of five (5) members. Political affiliation will be designated by the Town Charter.
