

**LEGAL NOTICE  
TOWN OF COVENTRY  
NOTICE OF ADJOURNED TOWN MEETING  
AND REFERENDUM**

“The electors and citizens qualified to vote in the Town Meetings of the Town of Coventry are hereby warned and notified that pursuant to Sections 9-1 and 9-3(e) of the Town Charter, an Adjourned Town Meeting and referendum will be held on November 28, 2017, between the hours of 6 A.M. and 8P.M. (E.T.) for the purpose of voting on the following questions:

1. Shall the 2017-2018 fiscal year appropriation of \$40,313,975, be approved?
  
2. “Resolution Appropriating \$5,400,000 For The Planning, Design, Renovation, Construction, Reconstruction And Improvements To The Booth And Dimock Memorial Library And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$5,400,000 Bonds Of The Town To Meet Said Appropriation And Pending The Issuance Thereof The Making Of Temporary Borrowings For Such Purpose’, as introduced and read at the Annual Town Meeting held November 17, 2017, be approved?”

The voting will be by paper ballot. Those desiring to vote in favor of a question shall mark the ballot in the space labeled “YES”. Those desiring to vote against a question shall mark the ballot in the space labeled “NO”.

The polls will be open during the hours between 6:00 o’clock A.M. and 8:00 o’clock P.M. Electors will vote at the polling places established for voting districts #1 and #2. The voters who are entitled to vote by reason of Section 7-6 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, revised to January 1, 2017, as amended, may vote at the Central Fire Station. Absentee ballots will be available in the office of the Town Clerk as provided by law.

The voting will take place pursuant to the provisions of the General Statutes, and the votes will be cast and canvassed and the results determined and certified as nearly as may be in accordance with the laws governing the election of Town Officials.

Copies of said bond resolution are on file and open to public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk.
