Subject: General Information

The Town of Coventry is very pleased with its 'Adopt-a-Road' program and especially grateful to the many participants who have volunteered their time in keeping our roads debris-free. It continues to be a very successful project.

I am offering the following instructions to those of you who are still participating and for those of you who are new to the program.

-  The Conservation Commission provides trash bags free of charge. They are available for pickup at the Planning office at the Town Hall between the hours of 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday through Wednesday; 8:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m., Thursday; 8:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. Friday.
-  Trash bags can be brought to the Public Works Department, 100 Olsen Farm Road (off Fern Road) to be put in the dumpster when open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. **Please check with the Public Works office before you place any trash bags in the dumpster.** Your name must be on the participants list in order to drop off the trash bags.
-  Town Hall accepts the drop-off of the trash bags only under extreme circumstances. **Please check with the Planning office before you place any trash bags in the dumpster.**
-  Roadside trash only, please; no personal trash.

If you who are no longer participating in the 'Adopt-a-Road' program, would please contact this office so we can have your name and street(s) removed from the list? We want to be sure that others who are interested in your area can sign up and assure that as many roads as possible are covered. Any questions you may have can be directed to the Planning office at 742-4062. You can also call Public Works Department at 742-6588 to be sure your name is on their list before dropping off trash.

**VOLUNTEER WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM**



*I, the undersigned, acknowledge, agree, and understand that:*

4. *I* voluntarily elect to accept and assume all risks or injury incurred or suffered by me (a) while participating in Adopt-a-Road; and (b) while on or upon the premises involved in such volunteer program.
5. *I*, for myself and for my family, heirs, successors and legal representatives hereby indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Coventry and its representatives, employees, agents, servants and independent contractors from and against all claims, demands, loss or injury to my person or property incurred through negligence, or other acts or omissions, however caused by myself or by an officer, employee, agent, leader, instructor, contractor, sponsor, official, representative or the Town of Coventry as a result of, or during my participation in the Adopt-a-Road Program.
6. *I* acknowledge that I have carefully read and fully understand this agreement and its contents. I am aware and agree that this is a release of liability and a contract between myself and the Town of Coventry, and I sign it of my own free will.
