

**TOWN OF COVENTRY
NOTICE OF ADJOURNED TOWN MEETING
AND REFERENDUM**

The electors and citizens qualified to vote in the Town Meetings of the Town of Coventry are hereby warned and notified that pursuant to Sections 9-1 and 9-3(e) of the Town Charter, an Adjourned Town Meeting and referendum will be held on May 3, 2022, between the hours of 6 A.M. and 8 P.M. for the purpose of voting on the following question:

“Shall the 2022-2023 fiscal year appropriation of \$44,239,440 be approved”?

The polls will be open during the hours between 6 A.M. and 8 P.M. Electors will vote at the polling places established for voting districts #1 and #2. The voters who are entitled to vote by reason of Section 7-6 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, may vote at the Central Firehouse.

The polling places are as follows:

District #1	District #2
Central Fire Station	No. Coventry Fire Station
1755 Main Street	3427 Main Street

Voting shall be by paper ballot. Those desiring to vote in favor of the question must mark the ballot in the space labeled “YES”. Those desiring to vote against said question must mark the ballot in the space labeled “NO”.

The polls will be opened during the hours between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. (EDT). Electors may vote at the polling places established for Districts #1 and #2. Other eligible Voters may vote at the Central Fire Station. Absentee Ballots will be available in the office of the Town Clerk as provided by law.

The vote will take place pursuant to the provisions of Section 9-1 and Section 9-3(e) of the Town Charter of the Town of Coventry, and pursuant to provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended. The votes will be cast and canvassed and the results determined and certified as nearly as may be in accordance with the laws governing the election of Town officials.
