1. All work covered by this application has been authorized by the owner of this property and will be performed according to all Local, State, and Federal laws, codes, regulations, and requirements.
2. Interior plumbing venting must be up to code before a sewer permit can be issued.
3. The Town will mark the location of the sewer main in the road for CBYD but will not mark out private property. Contractors are responsible for locating the sewer lateral on private property before they dig.
4. This permit will lapse/ expire if work is not completed within six months of approval.
5. An As-Built diagram must be submitted within **2 weeks** of job completion.

Sewer Connection Permit App Checklist

- All property taxes and trash fees must be current.
- Proposed sewer connection plan showing location of pipe, cleanouts, graywater connections, and separation distance to drinking water supply.
- A dewatering plan showing pump discharge location and sediment capture method.
- If the contractor knows the interior venting meets code the homeowner can schedule a venting inspection. If unsure check with the Building Official before scheduling the inspection.
- All sewer connection permits are \$200.
- Plumbers, property owners, or authorized agents can be the permit “Applicant”. The Applicant must be on site for all inspections.
- If the homeowner is authorizing someone else to be their agent/applicant they must state this in writing.
- Plumbers must provide a copy of their P-1 or P-7 license, liability & workers comp insurance (or waiver), and a \$6,000 license/permit bond made to “Town of Coventry” as Obligee and valid for 1 year.
- If the owner or their authorized agent is the applicant they must provide a \$6,000 bond (cash bonds are acceptable) and a signed “Hold Harmless” agreement.
